Volunteers of the library are an important support to the Pine River Public library. Volunteers add substantially to the limited resources available from the tax base. Community members interested in volunteering should submit an application to the Circulation Supervisor who will determine if we have a current need and match for the volunteer's skills.

The Library Board of Trustees encourages and supports the volunteers of the library. Volunteers are organized with one or more of the following objectives:

- To increase community awareness and use of the library
- To sponsor programs designed to add to the cultural life of the community
- To volunteer work in the library on specific projects designated by the Circulation Supervisor, and other staff members

Volunteers of the library are expected to follow the policies and procedures of the library. All volunteers working directly with children must agree to a background check prior to working at the library.
