## **DIY Paper Succulents**



## Making your own unique paper succulents is super easy! Just follow these simple steps for each pattern.

- 1. Place the pattern on top of a piece of the green paper.
- 2. Cut out all the shapes.
- 3. Use something to curl the edges of the leaves upward- a credit card works great. You can also use your fingers. Curl all leaves in the same direction.
- 4. Starting with the biggest cutout, glue each of the layers together with a dab of glue in the center the cutout. Tacky glue works best, but plain Elmers, a glue gun, or even a glue stick would be fine too. Make sure to offset the petals of each layer.
- 5. At this point you can emphasize the curls or folds more with your fingers to get a truly unique look.
