Displays/Exhibits Policy

The Pine River Public Library District (PRL) has multiple areas where displays are available for educational and enrichment purposes. The display areas are also used to enhance circulation of materials that are available to our patrons.

1. Items to be displayed are:
 - library materials
 - antiques/collectibles
 - artwork
 - handicrafts
 - hobby materials
 - decorative items that enhance the displays
2. Any other types of display items not fitting into the above categories must be approved by the Library Director.
3. Anyone wishing to use library display cases or areas must reserve them in advance with the Library Services Supervisor, who is in charge of the five display areas.
4. Displays are for a one-month period. (Renewable if available)
5. The Library reserves the right to use display cases and areas at any time.
